# **SPEAKER REQUIREMENTS**

Speakers agree to the following:

- To submit to the Event Organizer the final PowerPoint Presentation file by the due deadline.
- To provide all information, digital artwork, and materials related to the presentation to meet specifications.
- To be available to speak during any timeframe of the event as such will not request a change to the session time or day assigned.
- To be on time for his or her allotted presentation.
- Dress appropriately in business or business casual attire for their presentation.
- Fulfil their allotted presentation time slot and not go over-time.
- Presentation should be high quality, educational and informative in nature, which includes current, accurate and relevant information on the topic presented.
- Speech and conduct will be in a professional manner in every regard. This includes, avoiding jokes, references or innuendo of a sexual nature, references to individuals or groups by virtue of their membership in a particular religious, racial, or ethnic group that could be considered offensive, or use of profane language that could be considered offensive.
- Content and examples will be considerate of the cultural diversity of the audience.
- Respect Event Organizer as the host organization with either positive or neutral comments from the platform.
- Maintain an 'informational' opinion, objective and vendor-neutral, and not push a particular product or service before, during, or after presentation and further refrain from giving away or raffling any products or services during presentation.

### \* The Importance of Speakers Checking in on Time

For a Conference to run smoothly it is vital that Speakers arrive at the Event at the designated Speaker Registration Check-in Time. This is for peace of mind for the Event Organizer, Speaker Relations Staff and Event Emcee. Failing to check-in on time will result in uncertainty to the Event Organizer who would be put under undue stress and would be inconsiderate and unprofessional. If for some reason the Speaker cannot arrive at their designated check-in time, (such as interstate travel times) we expect that they will notify the Event Organizer prior to the event and provide an accurate time when they expect to be able to check-in on the date of their presentation.

### **SPEAKER SEATING & BRIEFING**

Speakers will have a reserved seating area near the platform for convenient access. It is mandatory for Speaker to arrive at the reserved seating area for the Session they are speaking a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the published Session start time to become familiar with the location of the Event Emcee and meet the Audio-Visual Technician who will go over Speaking Reminders and Procedures.

### SPEAKER TIME KEEPING

Speakers should allow a couple of minutes in the assigned time slot for the Event Emcee to introduce you. Be familiar with the location of the Time Keeper and regularly check for your time management to ensure you do not go overtime.

# **AUDIO-VISUAL EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE**

The Event Auditorium is equipped with the following standard audio-visual equipment;

- Shared PC laptop with Microsoft PowerPoint Application
- Digital Computer Projector with Screen with cabling to shared PC laptop
- Lectern
- Headset Microphone with Belt-pack
- Wireless Remote Control to advance and reverse your PowerPoint slides
- Internet will not be available for speaker presentations. No exceptions.



**Note:** Speakers cannot use their own laptop. PowerPoint Presentation Slide Decks will be sequenced in advance (prior to the Event days) with SlideDog Presentation Software on the shared PC laptop to facilitate a smooth transition from one speaker to the next and avoid disruptions. Speakers will not be able to check or make any changes to their presentation on the day of their session.

### POWERPOINT PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Please follow the guidelines below when preparing your presentation.

#### **General**

- Keep your message clear and brief.
- Keep the colour scheme consistent throughout your presentation.
- Consider a format that is a skeletal outline of the keynote presentation
- Include visual aids (graphs, tables, illustrations) in PowerPoint slides whenever possible that can be easily viewed in a large room
- Lines that are used for emphasis should be bolder than background lines or borders.
- Use contrasting text and background colors (e.g. white text on black background).
- Paragraphs should be clearly separated using a blank line.
- Lists should be organized using figures, dashes or bullet points. Please keep in mind that graphics and charts must be read from a considerable distance.

#### <u>Text</u>

• To ensure your presentation is easily visible from any seat in the room, please use the following minimum font sizes:

Title: Bold Typeface minimum 40 pt size

Subtitles: Bold Typeface minimum 32 or 36 pt size

Text and Figures: Bold Typeface minimum 24 or 28 pt size

Note: San- Serif fonts e.g. Arial or Verdana are easier to read in a large room

- Use dark primary colours for text.
- Use upper and lower case text (avoid ALL CAPITALS it is very difficult to read).
- Use contrasting text and background colors (white or yellow text on blue or black background).
- Avoid using the color red as it tends to bleed into the background and is generally difficult to read.

#### Graphics

- If your original graphs and graphics are too detailed or condensed they should be converted to a clearer, simpler format.
- Limit the use of clip art.
- Be careful with screen shots when viewed on full-screen they will look different.

#### <u>Layout</u>

- Keep the slides simple. Too much information on slides makes them hard for attendees to read/see.
- The 6×6 readability rule: no more than six words per line and six lines per page (i.e., Arial font size 40).
- Try to keep all text horizontal, even with charts.

### **Effects**

- Use the 'text-build' feature to stop the audience reading ahead of you.
- Do not include audio sounds such as bells, whistles, zooming sounds etc.
- Movies (AVI or MPEG files) should be embedded in the presentation.

#### **Technical Requirements**

- PowerPoint presentation must be Widescreen 16:9 format.
- Only PowerPoint presentations are accepted. Please note that only single projection will be available.
- Do not include live links to the Internet. If you wish to show web pages use screen shots within your PowerPoint presentation.
- If your PowerPoint presentation contains audio, video or unusual files, you must inform the Event Organizer in advance to ensure the necessary technical arrangements can be made.
- Presentations will be saved and run from a computer in the session room. You will still be in control of moving your slides back and forth.

- At the end of your presentation move the slide to the transition slide that is after your presentation.
- Embed graphs or figures into the document as independent objects; do not dynamically link from other programs.
- Attempt to limit file size to 25 MB and less. Photos for slides can be compressed and saved in a lower resolution.
- Disable any automatic advance timer on your file.

### **VIDEO OF PRESENTATION**

The video of Speakers presentation will be made publicly available on Event Organizer's official websites and Vimeo and/or YouTube account approximately two weeks after the completion of the Event.

The slide deck of Speaker's presentation will be made publicly available on Event Organizer's official websites and SlideShare account approximately two weeks after the completion of the Event.
